

Information for Non Canadian Residents coming to shoot the Saskatchewan Provincials

We have been in touch with the local firearms officer and been given the following information for non Canadians wishing to attend the match. If you require further information please contact us and we will put you in touch with their office.

RESTRICTED FIREARMS

Non-residents complete a [Non-Resident Declaration](#) when they are clearing Customs upon entry into Canada. The declaration serves as the temporary firearms license and registration certificate for the firearms they are declaring.

AUTHORIZATION TO TRANSPORT

All participants bringing a handgun (restricted firearm) into Canada require an A.T.T. before they can leave Canada Customs with it. It is recommended they obtain the A.T.T. prior to their arrival at the Canadian border (Canada Customs) so they have it in hand when they are making their Non-Resident Declaration and clearing customs. Participants applying for an A.T.T. are to complete the attached form and fax it to the SPSA. Participants should also have their event/match invitation in hand when they are clearing customs as they may be asked to produce it.

STORAGE AND TRANSPORTATION

Whether in a storage situation or a transportation situation the restricted firearm has to be disabled by a secure locking device and the restricted firearm has to be locked in a container that cannot be easily or readily broken into or broken open.
